2023-2024 State Required Selective Service Confirmation

The FAFSA Simplification Act was enacted into law as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021. Among other things, the law eliminated the requirement for male students to register with Selective Service before the age of 26 to be eligible for Title IV aid. Although Selective Service is not required for federal financial aid requirements, it is still a requirement to qualify for any state funding from the Higher Education Aids Board (HEAB) in the state of Wisconsin.

Males (any persons assigned the sex of male at birth) who are at least 18 years of age and not currently on active duty with the U.S. Armed Forces, or who were born after December 31, 1959, must be registered with Selective Service.

INSTRUCTIONS - According to our records, your Selective Service registration or exemption status was not confirmed by the Selective Service system. As a result you must provide written documentation as proof of your situation and take the appropriate action necessary.

- I was/am a noncitizen who first entered the United States after I turned 26. Include a copy of your I-94, I-551, or I551C or other legal documentation of entrance to the U.S.
- O I was/am a noncitizen who first entered the United States as a lawful nonimmigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S on the terms of that visa until after age 26. Include a copy of your I-94, I-551, or I551C or other legal documentation of entrance to the U.S.
- O I am in the Armed services and on active duty. **Include a copy of your active duty military identification card.** Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserves or National Guard who are not on active duty.
- O I have served as a member of one of the U.S. Armed Forces on active duty and received a DD-214 Form, and was released under a condition other than dishonorable. **Include α copy of your DD-214 Form (member copy 4).**
- O I am a citizen or national of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia. Include copy of your passport from the Freely Associated State or your I-94. Note: If you have lived in the United States for more than one year for any reason except as a student or employee of the government of your homeland, you must register.
