Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes § 38.14(9), Madison Area Technical College (“Madison College”) collects supplemental fees. Supplemental fees are used to fund a wide variety of programs that appeal to a diverse student body. The Student Activities Board is responsible for the disbursement of supplemental fees, with approval of the Student Senate in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes § 38.145. Supplemental fees to fund these activities are collected from all students, with the exception of apprentices, who are registered for degree credit courses at all Madison College campuses.

The amount of the per credit fee at the Madison College sites is 6.5% of the cost of an associate degree credit rounded up to the next \$.05 increment plus additional fees for services approved by the Student Senate, at the Madison sites. The amount of the fee assessed at the regional campuses is \$3.25 per associate degree credit.

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
