The premise of a learning college is to provide students with opportunities to be successful. The MAAP project is an essential strategy that will enhance our students’ ability to succeed by placing them in identified, entry-level courses for which they are academically prepared.

- Assessment: Students will be assessed before they can enroll in identified, entry-level courses
- Registration: The registration process will need to add a component whereby students are blocked from classes into which they have been placed
- Academic Advising: Trained advisors will need to be available to advise students about the courses their scores suggest they need to take
- Curriculum Development: Departments, such as math, English, science and social science, will need to adapt their curriculum to meet the needs of students who are assessed, advised and properly placed.
- Orientation: During orientation, students will need to be assessed, advised and placed in appropriate courses
- Instructional Design: Instructors will need to adapt their individual courses to meet the needs of the students enrolled in their courses

- ⊖ Class Scheduling: Courses will be scheduled based on identified student need

- ⊖ Mandatory assessment: Students enrolling in an identified, entry-level course will have an assessment of the skills necessary to be successful in that course.
- ⊖ Mandatory advising: Students enrolling in an identified, entry-level course will receive advising regarding their assessment results and appropriate placement in a timely fashion.
- ⊖ Mandatory placement: Students enrolling in an identified, entry-level course will be placed into the course for which they are academically prepared.

- ⊖ Students who engage in the MAAP process will have a lower rate of failure (D's, F's, or W 's) in math and English classes than students who did not engage in the MAAP process
- ⊖ More students who engage in the MAAP process will respond that they were academically prepared for their math and/or English courses 4-6 weeks into the semester than students who did not engage in the MAAP process.
- ⊖ Faculty will recognize 4-6 weeks into the semester that students who engage in the MAAP process are more academically prepared for their math and/or English courses 4-6 weeks into the semester than students who did not engage in the MAAP process
- ⊖ The advising process will help students to select courses for which they are academically prepared.
- ⊖ Students who participate in the MAAP process will register for classes into which they are advised
- ⊖ The MAAP process will provide information about course section needs for future planning
