A student must be a U.S. citizen or national, a U.S. permanent resident, or other eligible noncitizen to be eligible to receive Federal Student Aid. Please be aware that you will not receive financial aid until all documentation is received and reviewed. Therefore, failure to submit this form and any necessary documentation in a timely manner and/or provide accurate information may significantly delay the processing, awarding and potential disbursement of financial aid funds.

NON-CITIZEN INFORMATION & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Review the following information, select the statement that correctly identifies your situation, and submit documentation as directed. Please check **only one** and submit with a copy of the document listed:

I am a U.S. Permanent Resident:

- I have included copies of both sides of my current **Permanent Resident** or **Resident Alien card (Form I-551)**.
- I have included a copy of my **Arrival Departure Record (Form I-94)** or the Departure Record (**Form I-94A**) which is used at land border points of entry with the endorsement "*Processed for I-551. Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence. Valid until (must have not expired). Employment Authorized.*"
- I have included a copy of my **machine readable immigrant visa (MRIV)** in my unexpired passport. My MRIV shows an admission stamp, and the statement "*Upon endorsement serves as temporary I-551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year*" which appears directly above the machine readable section. The date of the endorsement on the stamp is less than 1 year old.

I am an eligible non-citizen:

- I have included a copy of my Arrival Departure Record (**Form I-94**) or Refugee Travel Document (**Form I-571**) with a stamp indicating one of the following: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Indefinite Parole" and/or "Humanitarian Parole," "Cuban-Haitian entrant, Status Pending," T-Visa Holder, or Designated Human Trafficking Victim.

Note: The following are NOT acceptable as proof of eligible non-citizen status:

- Employment Authorization card
- B-1 or B-2 Visitor Visa
- F-1, F-2 or M-1 Student Visa
- H or L series Visa
- J-1, J-2 Exchange Visitor Visa
- G series Visa
- Notice of Approval to Apply for Permanent Residence (I-171 or I-464)
- Period of Adjustment Letter/Receipt
- Application for permanent resident status (not yet approved)
- A U-1 Nonimmigrant Status
- Dream Act Deferred Status (DACA)
