Parent Rollover Clarification Form

IRA and Pension/Annuity plan disbursements are reported on IRS form 1099-R. 1099-R forms are sent to the recipient for tax filing purposes by the end of January each year from the custodial company of the plan. The 1099-R indicates if any portion of the distribution was untaxed and if any portion was a rollover. A rollover means that the disbursed funds were not sent to the recipient, but were instead transferred to a new plan. On the 19-20 FAFSA your parent(s) indicated that some or all of their 2017 untaxed IRA and/or Pension/Annuity disbursement(s) shown on their 1099-R(s) was a rollover.

Please be aware that you will not receive financial aid until all documentation is received and reviewed. Therefore, failure to submit this form and any necessary documentation in a timely manner and/or provide accurate information may significantly delay the processing, awarding, and potential disbursement of financial aid funds.
