## Selective Service Verification Form

All men who are at least 18 years of age and not currently on active duty with the U.S. Armed Forces, or who were born after December 31, 1959, must be registered with Selective Service. If you meet these qualifications and have not registered with Selective Service, you are not entitled to receive Title IV Federal Financial Aid until you register. Please be aware that you will not receive financial aid until all documentation is received and reviewed. Therefore, failure to submit this form and any necessary documentation in a timely manner and/or provide accurate information may significantly delay the processing, awarding and potential disbursement of financial aid funds.

**INSTRUCTIONS** - According to our records, your Selective Service registration or exemption status was not confirmed by the Selective Service system. As a result you must provide written documentation as proof of your situation and take the appropriate action necessary.

- I was/am a noncitizen who first entered the United States as a lawful nonimmigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S on the terms of that visa until after age 26. **Include a copy of your I-94, I-551, or I551C or other legal documentation of entrance to the U.S.**
- I am in the Armed services and on active duty. **Include a copy of your active duty military identification card.** (Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserves or National Guard who are not on active duty.)
- I have served as a member of one of the U.S. Armed Forces on active duty and received a DD-214 Form, and was released under a condition other than dishonorable. **Include a copy of your DD-214 Form.**
- I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia.
