SHUTTLES MEET AT MADISON COLLEGE DOWNTOWN AND SOUTH CAMPUS FOR EASY TRANSFERS or TO CATCH A METRO CITY BUS!

- **Route #5** serves Park Street (South Transfer Point/South Campus).
 - **Route #6** serves Downtown and Truax Campuses.
 - **Route #15** serves Downtown and West.
 - **Bus Route #18** serves Boys Girls Club and South Transfer Point/South Campus.
 - **Route #16** serves Bridge Lake Point, Badger Rock and South Transfer Point/South Campus.
- * Buses typically arrive/depart every 30 minutes.

EAST SHUTTLES: Boarding on Circle Driveway at Truax Campus Gateway (1701 Wright Street). **ROLLING STOP 5 to 10 minutes and 35 to 40 minutes after the hour at the main entrance at Commercial Ave. Campus** (2125 Commercial Ave.) and boarding on Dayton Street at the Downtown Campus (211 North Carroll Street). **If you are a volunteer or a customer of the River Food Pantry and want to be dropped off at the pantry at 2201 Darwin Road, please notify the driver before the shuttle departs from Truax.** The shuttle does not make pick ups at the pantry.
