- positive impact on other students
- attendance / volunteering / presentation / competition at international, national, state, local, or college events / workshops / conferences / competitions
- other reasons “why” the student stands apart from other students in his / her academic division (please indicate if this student
- digital photos of the student-in-action are encouraged & may be utilized as part of the Annual Celebration of Student Success
