

Outstanding Club Advisor of the Year

This award has been established to annually recognize one advisor from the Madison College faculty or staff who is actively involved with a student club and displays outstanding commitment to students. Any student club advisor is eligible to be nominated for this award. (Note: Advisors for student organizations ELT, Clarion, UCG, PAC, PTK, Senate, Volunteer Center and Yahara Journal are not eligible for this award.) Each of the nominees is announced and the selected advisor is presented with an award at *The Annual Celebration of Student Success Luncheon*. Note: No advisor will be awarded for 2 consecutive years.

In the nomination form, please state “why” the club Advisor deserves this award. Please type your response in the space provided on the nomination form. Include examples of the following:

- Accomplishments and awards received.
 - Leadership abilities and involvement in and outside the college.
 - Values and ethical behaviors demonstrated.
 - Demonstrated value for skills learned or enhanced by students.
 - Demonstrated value for his / her job(s) within the college community.
 - Positive impact on others (students, faculty, staff, community members, guests, etc.).
 - A personal story about this person.
- Other reasons “why” the advisor stands apart from other advisors at Madison College.

We will only accept nomination statements that are no more than 500 words.

- 1) Nominations / applications will be evaluated based on the criteria listed on the following pages.
- 2) Nomination of this student for this award, does not prevent nomination of the student for other awards at Madison College.
- 3) INCOMPLETE OR LATE NOMINATIONS / APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
