

Outstanding Student Employees of the Year Award

This award has been established to annually recognize three (3) Madison College students, who are work study / student help employees and exhibit the following values: (1) consistently meets or exceeds expectations for their position, (2) respects their vital role within the college, and (3) values the impact of their responsibilities. (*Note: This award is not intended for “tutors.” A separate and distinct award process exists for students who serve as “tutors.”*)

Each of the nominees is announced and the winning students will receive a plaque at *The Annual Celebration of Student Success Luncheon*.

Note: No students will be awarded for 2 consecutive years.

Eligibility:

- Enrollment in at least six (6) credits at Madison College during the semester of employment (fall and / or spring semester of the current academic year)
- Employed at least one semester
- Minimum, cumulative grade point average of 2.0, or above

In the nomination form, please state “why” the student employee deserves this award.

Please type your response in the space provided on the nomination form. Include examples of the following:

- Accomplishments
- Demonstrates a value for skills learned or enhanced.
- Positive impact on others (students, faculty and the college community).
- How has this Student enhanced your office/ department?
- Other reasons “why” the student stands apart from other students employees.

We will only accept nomination statements that are no more than 500 words.

- 2) Nomination of this student for this award, does not prevent nomination of the student for other awards at Madison College.
