

***The Karen Roberts Student Life Leadership Award
Outstanding Students of the Year***

This is the highest leadership honor annually presented to as many as 5 Madison College students, who have served in a variety of significant leadership roles on and off campus during their college career. Each of the nominees are announced and the selected students are presented with an award and monetary honorarium at *The Annual Celebration of Student Success Luncheon*. Note: No group will be awarded for 2 consecutive years.

Eligibility:

- Enrollment at Madison College during the current academic year (fall and / or spring semester)
- Minimum, cumulative grade point average of 2.5, or above

In the nomination form, please state “why” this person deserves this award. Please type your response in the space provided on the nomination form. Include examples of the following:

- Positions held and dates of involvement.
- Distinguished and significant service, contributions, accomplishments which have promoted leadership within the college community.
- Describe how they showed value for “community” by serving as a positive and ethical role model and mentor, leadership skills, participation or facilitation at events.
- Tell a story that describes this person.
- Other reasons “why” the student stands apart from all other students.

We will only accept nomination statements that are no more than 500 words.

Important notes:

- 1) Nominations / applications will be evaluated based on the criteria listed on the following pages.
- 2) Nomination of this student for this award, does not prevent nomination of the student for other awards at Madison College.
- 3) INCOMPLETE OR LATE NOMINATIONS / APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
